Academic standing is important, but not the sole factor in determining eligibility for the Award. Extra-curricular activities, leadership, community involvement and the pursuit of personal goals will also be considered. Please answer the following questions on one typed page total.

- Describe briefly your career or professional goals.
- Describe your participation in school activities, both academic and extracurricular. Include the years involved, positions held and any achievements.
- Describe community (out of school) activities; for example – part-time jobs, hobbies, clubs, projects. Include the years involved, positions held, and any achievements. Emphasize any volunteer activities over and above the required 40 hours.
- State any other pertinent information that you would like the selection committee to consider.

Your application will include:

- This completed page.
- Your single page in answer to the questions above.
- Photocopied transcript with your name clearly visible for all high school credits earned to date **AND** your mid-term marks for courses in progress.
- **Two signed** letters of reference substantiating your school/community achievements.
- Photocopy of the offer from the post-secondary institution you will be attending.
